How to renew your membership

【Overseas Membership (For members who live outside Japan)】

SBJ sent out a renewal form to each member by email and airmail on November 1, 2019. To renew your membership for 2020, please return the form **by December 13, 2019**. Payment can be made by credit card or by bank transfer.

【Active/Student Membership (For members who live in Japan)】

Domestic members will receive an invoice with a payment slip (furikomi-hyo) by post early December. Please make payment using the payment slip **by December 31, 2019**.

If you have not paid 2018 membership dues, you will receive an invoice for membership dues for two years.

- For members using automatic bank transfer, membership dues (Active membership: 9,800 JPY/Student membership: 5,000 JPY) will be automatically withdrawn from your account on **April 23, 2020** (tentative).
